

ART HIGGINS MEMORIAL "300 CLASSIC"

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Any Y.S.S.P.B.A. member may qualify by bowling a 300 game during their league play {(200 game for Seniors & Intellectual Disability leagues)(with or without handicap)} from the beginning of league bowling up to March 31st, 2010.
2. Individual league handicap will apply for qualifying and during the league roll-off.
3. Your league entries in the ZONE FINALS will be based on the following tables:
 - 4 to 20 registered members - 1 Finalist.
 - 21 to 40 registered members - 2 Finalists.
 - 41 to 60 registered members - 3 Finalists.
 - 61 to 80 registered members - 4 Finalists.
4. A league roll-off amongst the "Qualified" bowlers will be held during regular league play the week of APRIL 12-18,2010, to determine your "Zone Finalists". Finalists will be the top bowlers based on a 3 game total, plus regular handicap.
The above table will determine the number of finalists to advance to the Zone Round. (See Rule #3).
5. A bowler may qualify for league roll-off in each league in which he/she is a member, but may qualify only once for the ZONE FINALS. If a bowler qualifies for the Zone Finals in more than one league, he/she must qualify from the league in which he/she holds the highest average.
6. Each league should ensure that all eligible bowlers are included in the league roll-off.
7. **Zone Finals** will be held on MAY 2, 2010, at a site to be determined. The **Entry Deadline of April 25th, 2010 will be strictly enforced**. Three games will be bowled to determine the winners. Prizes will be awarded to all bowlers in order of finish.
8. Handicaps used in the Zone Finals will be based on 80% of the difference of the bowlers average and 250, with a maximum of 100 per game. Bowlers will use their highest Zone Average Book average. Bowlers without an
Average Book average will use their highest league average as of April 6th, 2008.
9. All O.S.P.B.A. Rules and regulations will be used during the Zone Finals.
10. In the Zone Finals, bowlers arriving late will be permitted to start bowling in the frame in which the bowlers on
his/her lanes are bowling in. Bowlers arriving after the 4th frame will not be allowed to bowl.
11. A substitute may bowl, if necessary, providing he/she has qualified by bowling a 300 (200) game during league play and by bowling in the league roll-off. Scoreboards will be required.
12. The decisions of the Tournament Committee will govern all disputes and interpretations of the Rules. The Tournament Committee's decision will be final.
